*Option not available on August 16 which precedes the August Recognized Event. The courses will be closed.

- The emphasis of our Schooling Evenings will be on a relaxed competition.
- Casual boots, breeches, polo or other conservative shirt, and protective headgear with harness are required. Vests too if schooling cross country afterward.
- All horses must have a current negative Coggins to be included with registration form
- YOU design your evening do as much as you want...it is as easy as that!

FORMAT: Create your evening and choose from the following options:

<u>Dressage FIX A TEST</u>: Receive comments and suggestions from the judge; choose any test you wish - \$40 <u>Show Jumping Rounds</u>: \$30 for the first two rounds at any height -2 round minimum. Add additional rounds with an open check, credit card or cash payment at show-\$10 each additional round <u>Gamblers Choice</u>: Register separately for \$15 round. Riders must sign up for this class at registration <u>Cross Country Schooling</u>: Register with entry or at arrival. \$50/horse or \$40 if also show jumping

PLEASE NOTE: Dressage FIX A TEST requires advanced registration. You may add show jump rounds, cross country schooling, gambler's choice and alter jump classes when you check in at the Office.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS:

- Use entry form provided below.
- **Dressage FIX A TEST requires advanced sign up** —register before 9 pm on the Sunday before the Schooling Evening to reserve your time!
- STARTING TIMES for ALL Dressage will be posted on the website by 9 pm Monday. Dressage starts between 3 and 4pm.
- No Ribbons will be awarded for Dressage FIX A TEST or Show Jumping—this is strictly a schooling opportunity for you and your horse! Your dressage test is available that evening after you complete the test and/or talk with the judge.
- **Ribbons** and a \$50 Waredaca BUCKS certificate will be awarded to the winners of the Gamblers Choice Classes.
- Late arrivals may not be able to be accommodated.
- Dress is the same for all phases—boots or boots/half chaps, breeches and a shirt with sleeves. Vests if cross country schooling.
- Watch for parking signs as you approach Waredaca.
- Check-in at Indoor Arena Show Office.
- Dogs welcome, but must be leashed at all times.
- Bring your own water.
- No food available for purchase, but a soda machine is present.
- Vet and Farrier on call.
- Bridle Numbers will be given out.

What is the Gamblers Choice?

In this competition, a certain number of obstacles are set up in the arena. Each obstacle carries from 10 to 100 points according to its difficulty. Points for each obstacle will be marked on the course. Combination obstacles are not allowed. The obstacles will be built so that they can be jumped in both directions.

Each competitor has 30 seconds. During this time, he may jump all the obstacles he wishes in any order and in any direction. The competitor is credited with the number of points carried by each obstacle that he has jumped correctly and without fault. No points are awarded for an obstacle knocked down.

The start and finish line will be marked. Sounding the whistle signals the rider to proceed to the start and begin; the whistle also declares the end of the 30 second round. The competitor must then cross the finish line in the proper direction to allow his time to be recorded. If he does not cross the finish line, he is placed last of the competitors with the same number of points. During the round, competitors may cross the start and finish lines in either direction.

When the fixed time of 30 seconds occurs the whistle will signal. If the fixed time is reached at the moment when the horse is already taking off (front hooves off the ground), this obstacle counts if it is correctly jumped.

Any obstacle knocked down during a round will not be rebuilt; if it is jumped again, no points will be credited to the competitor. The same applies for knocking down an obstacle in a disobedience or for displacing a lower part positioned in the same vertical plane. In the case of a disobedience without a knock-down, the competitor may jump that obstacle or continue to the next obstacle.

After a fall, a competitor must stop, retire and forfeit all points The competitor who has obtained the highest number of points will be declared the winner. In the event of equality of points for first place, there will be a single jump-off according to the same formula with a fixed time of 20 seconds.

Each rider may only compete in the class once per height level but can enter two consecutive height levels, ie 3'0 and 3'3.

Each Gamblers Choice Winner receives a ribbon and Waredaca BUCKS \$50 award, good for any Waredaca sponsored activity.
