Equestrian rider safety is a serious concern for riders, parents, and professionals. A common challenge all riders face is the risk of catastrophic injuries resulting from falls. Every ride can result in a fall, but certain scenarios introduce more risk than others. -

LANDSAFE is a progression-focused program that focuses on reducing rider risk through a real-life Equine simulator, incorporating fall-technique training and much more.
