On **Saturday**, riders will have the choice of riding at the farm in the morning or joining Richard at Fair Hill International for a XC schooling lesson in the afternoon.

On **Sunday**, we will be back at the farm and Richard will gear the lessons based on which lesson you rode the day before.

During the clinic, Richard will help the riders improve their horse's balance, rhythm and adjustability on the flat and over fences.

Groups will be limited to 5 riders in up to 2 hr sessions - Private and semi-private lessons are available if the schedule allows.

Horses and Riders of similar experience may be grouped together

1. **Beginning Horse/Rider - up to 18"**
2. **Fence height – up to 2'3**
3. **Fence height – up to 2'7**
4. **Fence height – up to 2'11**
5. **Fence height – up to 3'3**
6. **Fence height – up to 3'7**

Late entries will be accepted, if space allows, with a \$10/day late fee.

If mailing and riding only **one** of the days, please include: the completed application/release plus a check payable to Richard Lamb for \$115. Or, include a non-refundable deposit check (\$35) to hold your space. (After 9/16, add late fee of \$10)
